

Pinot Noir

Luigi Bosca Reserva Argentina \$36/\$9.00

Smooth, velvety body. Red fruit aromas, strawberry and chocolate notes. Elegant, good tannins.

Erath Willamette Valley Oregon \$38/ \$9.50

Luscious aromas of ripe strawberries, vanilla, graham and hint of caramel.

Merlot

Ghost Pines Napa Valley California \$34/\$8.50

Jammy black cherry and blackberry, toast, mocha, and even a touch of smokey dried rosemary.

Casa Lapostolle Chile \$28/\$7.00

Ripe berry fruit and light oak notes leading to a long chocolaty finish. Medium to full body.

Shiraz/Syrah

Tait "The Ballbuster" Australia \$40

Bold flavors of blackberry, vanilla, chocolate and cinnamon. Finishes tart and juicy, with coffee and olive shadings.

Layer Cake South Australia \$30/\$7.50

It's creamy in texture, and filled with blueberries, spice, finally ending with hints of coffee and chocolate.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Louis Martini Sonoma County California \$32/\$8

Rich and dry, with a smooth, tannic structure framing ripe flavors of blackberries, cherries, smokey oak and dusty Asian spices.

Hogue Columbia Valley Washington \$30/\$7.50

Bright fruit dominated by plum and black cherry, continuing with a minty-black-olive set of flavors and a medium-weight finish.

Zinfandel

Rancho Zabaco "Heritage Vines" California \$32/\$8.00

It's quintessential Sonoma Zin, with briary flavors of wild cherries and raspberries, and coatings of chocolate, anisette, bacon and spices.

Four Vines "Old Vine Cuvee" California \$28/\$7.00

On the palate, blackberry and spicy plum fruit with a rich mouth feel. Big and opulent on the mid palate with plenty of structure, trailing to a velvety toasted oak finish.

Malbec

Aqua de Piedra Gran Reserva Argentina \$30/\$7.50

Bright, fresh and fruity on the palate, with plenty of pretty plum, cherry, raspberry, vanilla, spice and herb flavors.

Maipe Chile \$28/\$7.00

Sweet aromas that verge on syrupy set up a sweet and easy palate of black cherry and cassis.

High Note Argentina \$33/\$8.25

Violet in color with intense sweet spice on the palate balanced by notes of plums, cassis, blackberries and black cherries. It's creamy, smooth and ripe in the mouth with soft round tannins and a long silky finish

Red Blends/ Meritage

Black Ankle Vineyards "Rolling Hills" Mt. Airy Maryland \$35/\$8.75

Ruby/plum color with a nose of black fruits, dark chocolate, and hints of tobacco and licorice. In the mouth the Rolling Hills reveals an abundance of cassis, blackberry jam, and sweet, velvety tannins.

Riesling

Snoqualmie "Naked" Columbia Valley Washington \$30/\$7.50

Round, spicy fruit and a pleasing lushness in the midpalate. Lemon tea and hints of sweet honey are backed with enough acid to give it plenty of grip.

Columbia Winery "Cellar Masters" Columbia Valley Washington \$30/\$7.50

Floral aroma with hints of peach, quince, lime and clove delight the nose. Rich and full-flavored fruit on the palate is balanced by refreshing, crisp acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc

Nobilo Marlborough New Zealand \$30/\$7.50

Melon, grapefruit and passion fruit in abundance, followed by a finish that's marked by green herbs.

Kenwood Sonoma County California \$30/\$7.50

Ripe, bright grapefruit, passion fruit, lemon and herb flavors. It's light and refreshing.

Chardonnay

Four Vines Naked Santa Barbara California \$32/\$8.00

This un-oaked chardonnay's rich in tropical fruit, peach, pear and citrus flavors with a crisp finish.

St Francis Sonoma County California \$33/\$8.25

Fruit and pear aromas are complimented by hints of oak and vanilla. This medium to full bodied Chardonnay has ripe fruit flavors, crisp high acid in the mouth, and a rich lingering finish.

Casa Lapostolle Chile \$28/\$7.00

Expressive aromas of tropical fruit and sweet citrus fruit. Touches of honeycomb and elegant sweet spices add an extra layer of complexity.

Viognier

Michael David "Incognito" Lodi California \$38

Flambéed pear and honeysuckle aromas open up into flavors of passion fruit, green apple and a lingering dried apricot finish. Rich and opulent with explosive flavors.

Pinot Gris

Erath Oregon \$30/\$7.50

Bright fresh aromas of banana and honeydew melon with tropical fruit, lemon and floral notes that are seamlessly balanced with a clean lift of acidity,

King Estate Oregon \$32

Pear, pineapple and light tropical flavors. It's textural and tangy, with a pleasing citrus skin finish.

Spain

Tapena Verdejo Spain \$26/\$6.50

Has the smell and taste of tropical fruits with ripe peaches and citrus with floral notes.

Martin Codax Albarino Spain \$30/\$8.00

The wine is a clear, light lemon color with a pronounced, somewhat playful nose. Shows tree fruits ripe apple, white pear, apricot, and peach.

White Zinfandel

Beringer California \$22/\$5.50

The focus is to highlight the fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors, and round them out with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove.
